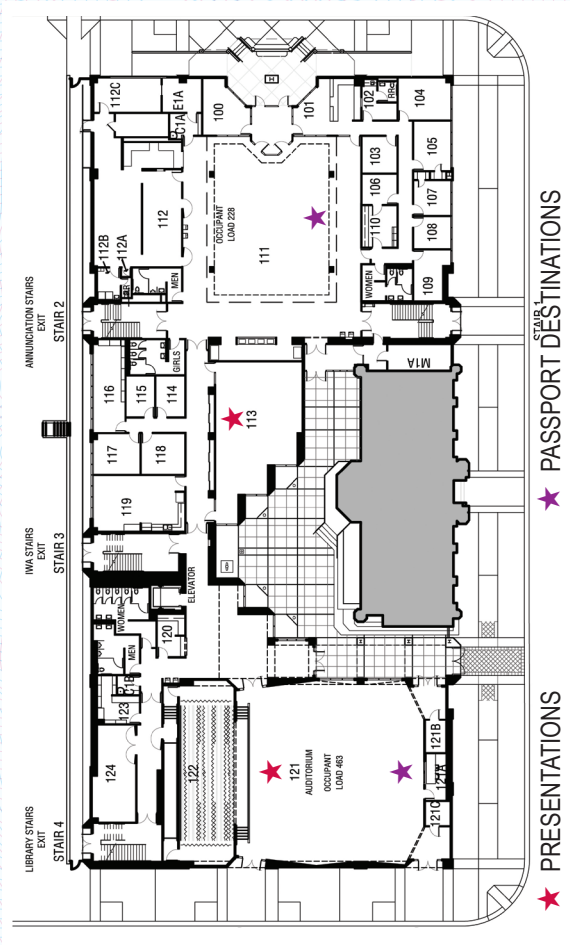

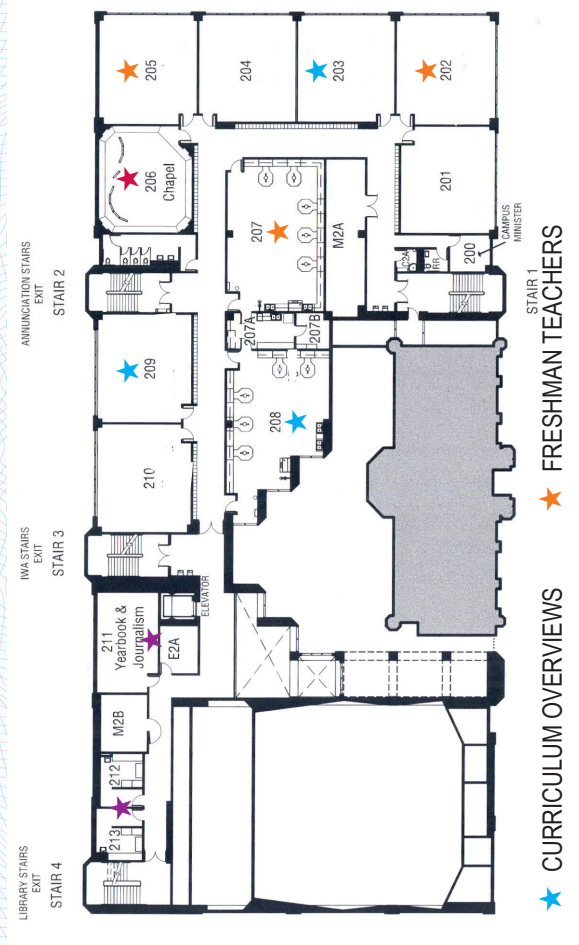
FIRST FLOOR MAP
